Recap: What is a Mandate?

- ▶ Mandate defined:

an official order or commission to do something – it is concise, specific and clear

- ▶ Example: Story of Esther



- ▶ Characteristics of a Mandate:

- ▶ It is given by someone in authority (it can be given by God or even Satan)
- ▶ It must be received or rejected (the giver reserves the right to withdraw or give it to another person)
- ▶ It has a timeline and guidelines for completion
- ▶ It carries provisions for its implementation

History of WWW

- ▶ This Apostolic and Prophetic move of God started in Port Harcourt in May 1998 with a cry from God's heart to His daughters concerning the spiritual state of the Church and the Nigerian nation. Through prophetic utterance, the Lord specifically asked that women be raised from the 36 states of Nigeria (across denominational boundaries) to intercede for the church and the nation. He promised that if women came before Him in true repentance, He would avert the impending judgment on the nation and after that He will begin to send them to other Nations of the world.
- ▶ From the first mobilization effort, the women have held several solemn assemblies in the regions and Nations around the world. So far teams of wailing women have carried God's messages to over 100 countries across the globe.



The call of the Wailing Women is contained in the foundational scripture: Jeremiah 9:17-21 (KJV)

- ▶ 17 Thus saith the LORD of hosts, Consider ye, and call for the mourning women, that they may come; and send for cunning women, that they may come: 18 And let them make haste, and take up a wailing for us, that our eyes may run down with tears, and our eyelids gush out with waters. 19 For a voice of wailing is heard out of Zion, How are we spoiled! we are greatly confounded, because we have forsaken the land, because our dwellings have cast us out. 20 Yet hear the word of the LORD, O ye women, and let your ear receive the word of his mouth, and teach your daughters wailing, and every one her neighbour lamentation. 21 For death is come up into our windows, and is entered into our palaces, to cut off the children from without, and the young men from the streets.

Assignment for breakout groups

- ▶ The move of the Wailing Women Worldwide is essentially a call to prayer. It is the Lord Himself raising a Global Army of Spirit-filled women to labour in fervent intercession for the cleansing and unity of the universal church and the redemption of the Nations of the world until “the Kingdom of the world become the Kingdoms of our God and of His Christ and He will reign forever”. It is an apostolic and a prophetic move of God.
 - ▶ Participants will be broken down into 3 or 4 groups
 - ▶ Each group will be given (5) minutes to examine the call of WWW which is contained in Jeremiah 9:17-21, and highlight as many principles as possible related to mandate
 - ▶ One person will present the Findings from each group at the end of the breakout segment

What God wants to accomplish through our prayers:

- ▶ Recreate all nations in righteousness
- ▶ Strengthen the unity of the church universally (John 17:21)
- ▶ Shield the man-child company from attacks of Satan
- ▶ Release prisoners from bondage all over the world (Isaiah 61:1-4)
- ▶ Provoke a worldwide flood of tears of repentance from sin and wickedness (Jeremiah 9:1,18)
- ▶ Usher in a might wave of revival in righteousness as never before in the history of the world. This will come as a necessary prelude to the great end-time harvest of souls who otherwise could perish in the valley of decision (Joel 3:12-14; Habakkuk 3:2)
- ▶ Release a shield of deliverance and protection over the state of Israel by praying fervently for the peace of Jerusalem, the City of the Great King (Psalm 122:6-9)

The heart-attitude required for this mandate:

1 Corinthians 1:26-31

- ▶ 26 For ye see your calling, brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called: 27 But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; 28 And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are: 29 That no* flesh should glory in his presence*. 30 But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us* wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: 31 That, according as it is written, He that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord.

Micah 4:10,12 KJV:

- ▶ 10 Be in pain, and labour to bring forth, O daughter of Zion, like a woman in travail: for now shalt thou go forth out of the city, and thou shalt dwell in the field, and thou shalt go even to Babylon; there shalt thou be delivered; there the LORD shall redeem thee from the hand of thine enemies.
- ▶ 12 But they know not the thoughts of the LORD, neither understand they his counsel: for he shall gather them as the sheaves into the floor.

What should we pray for?

Family

- Families: it is our duty to pray that families may be strengthened and rightly positioned as the basic unit of society. That broken families will be reunited and restored in harmony.
- Repentance from dead works: WWW must call men, women and children to repent from sin.
- Individuals: we must pray that they might be saved from sin and delivered from hell.

Church

- The unity and the strength of the Church of Jesus Christ on the earth (John 17:21)
- Deliverance from sin and the curse of the law of sin.
- Reconciliation to God (2 Corinthians 5:18-21)
- Restoration: pray for the restoration of redemptive gifts of people, nations and cities. We are called to pray for the realization of the purpose for which God created them.

Nation

- Nations and leaders at every level in society (1 Timothy 2:2)
- People groups especially those who have not yet heard the gospel (1 Timothy 2:2)
- The salvation of souls in every nation: all men regardless of race, nationality or status.

What should WWW do with the specific mandate we have received?

- ▶ Obedience – be careful to follow pattern and do the work in the way the Lord has asked us to do it.
- ▶ Call for WWW in our different locations (raise and disciple WWW in our neighbourhoods, cities and nations).
- ▶ Continue to pray, fast, cry out against iniquity, mourn for the souls of lost sinners, and ask the Lord to save them, as well as call solemn assemblies in which we enlist the help of other Christians around the world to intercede for nations, cities, communities and families (in humility, love and unity).
- ▶ We must mobilise men, women and young people and move forward as:
 - ▶ United compact teams, caring for each other and running errands for the Lord, not man
 - ▶ Esteemed and informed intercessors, wailing, mourning and standing in the gap for sinners
 - ▶ Prophetic gate keepers, guarding the gates of our families, cities and nations
 - ▶ Tenderhearted evangelists going into every nook and cranny in our nation to take the gospel to lost sinners everywhere (brothels, hospitals, prisons, orphanages, schools)
 - ▶ Light of the world and Salt of the earth
