DISCIPLINE

DEFINITION

Merriam- Webster define discipline as:-

- The practice of training people to obey rules or a code of behavior, using punishment to correct disobedience.
- 2. Self-control.
- 3. Punishment.
- Training that corrects, molds, or perfects the mental faculties or moral character.
- 5. A field of study.
- To punish or penalize for the sake of enforcing obedience and perfecting moral character.

Every Soldier must be disciplined. There is a lot of indiscipline in My people. I want to inculcate discipline in My people. When they are disciplined, they will discipline others, and others will take a cue from them. Let discipline be taught.

WHAT IS DISCIPLINE

- IT IS AN ORDERLY WAY OF DOING THINGS.
- ► RIGHT WAY OF BEHAVIOUR
- ► RIGHT ATTITUDE
- **LAWFULLY ACTIONS WITHOUT COMPLUSION**
- ► DOING WHAT IS RIGHT WITHOUT PRESSURE OR APPLICATION OF FORCE.
- ▶ DOING WHAT IS RIGHT WHEN NOT BEING WATCHED.

PUNISHMENT

Punishment is defined as:-

- 1. The act of punishing.
- 2. Suffering, pain, or loss that serves as retribution.
- 3. A penalty inflicted on an offender through judicial procedure.
- Severe, rough, or disastrous treatment.

Prov 11:21 though hand join in hand, the wicked shall not be unpunished: but the seed of the righteous shall be delivered.

DISCIPLINE - GOD'S WAY

Rev 3:19 Those whom I love I rebuke and discipline. So be earnest and repent.

Prov 3:11-12 My son, do not despise the Lord's discipline, and do not resent his rebuke, 12 because the Lord disciplines those he loves, as a father the son he delights in.[b]

Job 5:17-18 Blessed is the one whom God corrects; so do not despise the discipline of the Almighty. For he wounds, but he also binds up; he injures, but his hands also heal.

Psa 94:12-13 Blessed is the one you discipline, Lord, the one you teach from your law, you grant them relief from days of trouble, till a pit is dug for the wicked.

Heb 12: 4-11

Discipline flows from the Godhead. Whatever God say Jesus echoes and whatever Jesus say the Holy Spirit echoes. John 5:17, 19

It involves putting oneself under control i.e Self control. Not operating in the flesh.

- What we watch and listen to.
- Attitudes and behaviour.

INDISCIPLINE

Definition: –

- A situation in which people do not control their behaviour or obey rules.
- 2. Breakdown of law and order

Consequences:-

- Breakdown.
- Dissolution.
- End of agreement.
- Closure of businesses, Churches, clubs
- Turmoil in Nations

EXAMPLES OF PRACTICAL INDISCIPLINE

- Not obeying the rules and regulations of an organization, the State or the Nation.
- Deliberate breaking of traffic rules and regulations.
- ▶ Not paying our taxes, tithe etc.
- ▶ Not taking our turn in public places, littering, impatience.
- Quarrelling and using indecent abusive language.
- Inhumane behaviour.
- Destruction of lives and property.
- Cri/me and violence.

MARKS OF A DISCIPLINED LIFE

□The persons is prepared to repent and learn from their mistakes. □Being humble, mature and operates in wisdom. □ Exercise self control and inner restraint. □Do not talk too much because in the multitude of words, there lacks no sin. □Brings about progress; they are progress minded. □Focused. ☐ Has time management skills and is organized.

HOW TO LIVE A DISCPLINED LIFE

- We must first receive from the Lord and abide absolutely in what HE has called us to do.
- ► We must live in accordance with the kingdom's lifestyle, as contained in the Bible. Must follow and obey the commands and commandments of God. Matt 5, 6
- ▶ We must train our minds and character. Allowing ourselves to be led and controlled by the Holy Spirit. Gal 5:22-25, Eph 1:18, 2 Cor 5:7
- ▶ We must be disciplined in our thoughts as sin committed in our thoughts are equally grievous before God. Prov 12:5, Eph 4:17.
- Fill our minds with the word of God. Psalm 119:9-13, Col 3:16
- We must be disciplined in speech. A woman disciplined in speech is truly disciplined.


QUESTIONS A DISCIPLINED PERSON MUST ASK THEMSELVES

My daughters, I am militant in nature and I have called you as soldiers. If you want Me to leave you and civilians I will, But if you want Me to train you, I will. The choice is yours. If you want to be a good soldier you have to submit to the required training. Develop the discipline of a soldier. You have to be militant in nature. But if you want ME to leave you as civilians. I will leave you to do your own thing. And go the way you want to go. Without training, you cannot be toughened; And you can't handle serious matters. You will be chicken hearted. Without training, you can't be brave, take risks, or be adventurous. No training is joyous for the moment. But after, it gives joy to the person who has submitted to the rigours of training. Like a good solider of the Lord, you must endure hardship. If you want Me to withdraw My hand from training you I will withdraw. That is why I told you that this is a unique move. I am not working with civilians but with soldiers. I am working with an army and there is a difference. For a civilian is free in so many ways. But a soldier is subjected to discipline.

A soldier I confined. A soldier takes orders. A soldier does not do as he wants. But as the commander directs. A civilian does not go to battle; It is a soldier that fights battles. For a soldier to be fit for combat and stand in the face of war. He has to be trained and function like a soldier.
